Charles Tillotson, Christie Nielsen and Angelina Vicknair were present representing the Port.

The Prayer and Pledge was dispensed with .

The following items were deferred:

- 9f, "A Resolution authorizing the execution of a Master Goods and Services Agreement (MSGA) and Riders to proceed with Phase 3 and Phase 4 of the 11-mile Rail Extension Project and funding the additional cost for the project; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto" and
- 9g, "A Resolution authorizing the Executive Director of the Plaquemines Port, Harbor, & Terminal District to introduce and implement the Master Plan as a foundation for the strategic planning to secure the Port's competitive edge and operational excellence; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto".

There being no matters for Executive Session, Commissioner Champagne moved to Agenda Item 3, "Status Report by the Executive Port Director. Without objection, so ordered. Mr. Tillotson reported the following:

- **Financial Update**: The Total Net Position: \$120,424,259; Unrestricted Fund Balance: \$3,881,326; Land Fund Restricted Balance details are pending. The Budget vs. Actual-Revenues Revenues are \$48,067,042 vs. \$13,385,197 and Expenses are \$62,997,265 vs. \$13,022,786;
- **State Port Investment Commission:** The Port has been shortlisted as a Deepwater port under consideration and a decision is expected by the end of August;
- Sustainability Partners Agreement: Phases 3 and 4 Commission approvals are pending today's vote, with 16% cost increase and the estimated project completion is summer 2024;
- Walker Road Vehicle Bridge: The groundbreaking is set for the third quarter of 2026 and completion is planned to be by the fourth quarter of 2027. Funding for this project is supported by a \$7.4 Port RAISE Grant;
- Master Plan and Capital Improvement Plan (CIP): The Master Plan is finalized. CIP finalizing graphic design completion is crucial for Port marketing over five years;
- **Financial Audit and Process Improvements**: The 2023 audit is completed and they are focusing on process for improvements. Monthly random audits are requested for process control;
- PALH Ferry Landing Emergency Repair: The Port is finalizing legal clarifications with Deep South and the contract execution is pending these discussions; and
- Port Building A/C replacement will be taking place tomorrow and Saturday. The Port Staff will telecommute on Friday and 911 will work from the Belle Chasse Fire Station.

There being no matters to address under Item 4, "Bids and Advertisements", Commissioner Champagne moved to Agenda Item 5, "Introduction of Ordinances and Resolutions". Without objection, so ordered. The following legislation was introduced:
